1 What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? 2 You desire but do not have, so you kill. You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight. You do not have because you do not ask God.

3. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1). In their conflict, the Heart of the Matter was a Matter of their Hearts.(Vs. 1-2)
- 2). When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives. (Identify them)
- 3). What causes undying lusts for things of the world that corrupts human behavior?

4. You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God?

Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a *friend* of the world becomes an enemy of God.
