BACKGROUND

The book of Revelation provides the clearest biblical portrait of the events of the tribulation, dealing with the specifics of that terrible time (chapters 4-18). The tribulation will be a time of judgment, a time when those left on the earth after the rapture will suffer deeply for their nonbelief.

BACKGROUND

Revelation portrays Christ's future triumph over the forces of evil and His re-creation of the world for the redeemed. Ultimately, the book—and the world—end in a final victory for truth and goodness and beauty. payment will be exacted from those not covered by the blood of Jesus Christ

REVELATION 21:1-2 NIV

- 1. Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea,
- 2. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

REVELATION 21:3 NIV

3. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.

REVELATION 21:4-5 NIV

- 4. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
- 5. He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Then he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."

REVELATION 21:6-7 NIV

6. He said to me: "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life. 7. Those who are victorious will inherit all this, and I will be their God, and they will be my children.

- 1). John's vision is a fulfillment of prophecy spoken in Isaiah 65:17–18.
- 2). In this new Holy City God dwells among his people freely.
- 3). The events recorded by John are a promise of completion from the Alpha & Omega.

REVELATION 21:8 NIV

8.But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."
