Points of Information – Chronicles

1 and 2 Chronicles were originally one Book.

It is believed that Ezra wrote the Chronicles, after the Babylonian exile.

Points of Information – Chronicles

John MacArthur's Bible Commentary says this: "1 Chronicles is the partner of 2 Samuel, in that both detail the reign of King David."

Regarding today's text, the Life Application Study Bible notes that "several parts of this song are parallel to songs in the Book of Psalms." [Psalms 95, 105 and 106]

Points of Information – Chronicles

The Holman Bible Dictionary says: "Much of the material [in Chronicles] came from the Books of Samuel and Kings."

Lesson Context

The first 9 Chapters of 1 Chronicles provide an extensive and highly detailed genealogy, beginning with Adam.

The death of King Saul is recorded in Chapter 10.

Lesson Context

Chapters 11 and 12 of 1 Chronicles describe the beginning of David's reign as King.

Chapter 13 tells how King David retrieved and moved the Ark of the Covenant [unfinished business].

Lesson Context

Chapters 14 and 15 detail King David's wives, his conquests of the Philistines and further handlings of the Ark of the Covenant.

Chapter 16 begins with King David's blessing of his people and additional instructions for the Levites, regarding the Ark of the Lord.

1 Chronicles 16:8 [NLT]

Give thanks to the LORD and proclaim His greatness. Let the whole world know what He has done.

Lesson Context

Just before today's text, Verse 16:7 sets the stage for our lesson:

On that day David gave to Asaph and his fellow Levites this song of thanksgiving to the Lord:

Sing to Him; yes, sing His praises. Tell everyone about His deeds.

Exult in His holy Name; rejoice, you who worship the LORD.

Search for the LORD and for His strength; continually seek Him.

Remember the wonders He has performed, His miracles, and the rulings He has given,

O nations of the world, recognize the LORD, recognize that the LORD is glorious and strong.

Give to the LORD the glory He deserves! Bring your offering and come into His presence. Worship the LORD in all His holy splendor.

Let all the earth tremble before Him. The world stands firm and cannot be shaken.

Let the heavens be glad, and the earth rejoice! Tell all the nations, "The LORD reigns!"

Let the sea and everything in it shout His praise! Let the fields and their crops burst out with joy!

Let the trees of the forest sing for joy before the LORD, for He is coming to judge the earth.

Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! His faithful love lives forever.

Cry out, "Save us, O God of our salvation! Gather and rescue us from among the nations, so we can thank Your holy Name and rejoice and praise You."

Praise the LORD, the God of Israel, who lives from everlasting to everlasting! And all the people shouted "Amen!" and praised the LORD.

Remember this:

Let us <u>not</u> limit our praises to the Lord.
